ORDINANCE NO. 03-2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 103, PLEASANT TOWNSHIP SEWER SERVICE CHARGES ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Pleasant Township, Warren County, adopted Ordinance No. 103 on October 8, 1963, which Ordinance requires connection to a sanitary sewer system in Pleasant Township; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Pleasant Township deem it advisable and in the best interest of the Township to impose a surcharge on any customer of the sanitary sewer system in Pleasant Township in violation of Ordinance No. 103, as amended, in the manner hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Pleasant Township deem it advisable and in the best interest of the Township to determine said surcharge imposed by Ordinance No. 103 to be established by Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Supervisors of Pleasant Township do enact and ordain, and it is enacted and ordained for Pleasant Township, Warren County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. The current Section 7 of Ordinance No. 103 shall be amended to include another paragraph as the final paragraph of Section 7 as follows:

Subject to the foregoing, no person shall deposit anything into the sanitary sewer system other than human waist and toilet or facial tissue, including, without limitation, baby or disinfectant wipes, napkins or paper towels, dental floss, egg shells or coffee grounds,

fats, oils and greases, diapers, sanitary napkins, tampons or condoms or rubber gloves. In the event that the Township determines that any sewer customer, or group of customers, are violating this provision, the Township may impose a surcharge on such customer or group of customers, the amount of which shall be determined by the Board of Supervisors and established by Resolution duly adopted by the Board of Supervisors.

2. In all other respects, Pleasant Township Ordinance No. 103 shall remain unchanged.
